DAFFODILS

William Wordsworth tells us about a very happy moment the poet experienced in nature. One day, he was walking alone when he suddenly saw many yellow daffodil flowers beside a lake. The flowers were moving in the breeze and looked as if they were dancing together.

“A crowd, a host, of golden daffodils.”

He felt that the daffodils were happier and more lively than the waves of the lake. Their beauty filled him with joy and made him forget his loneliness. The flowers seemed cheerful and spread happiness all around.

“Tossing their heads in sprightly dance.”

Later, whenever the poet sat alone or felt sad, the memory of these daffodils came back to him. Remembering them filled his heart with peace and pleasure.

“And then my heart with pleasure fills.”

The poem teaches that nature refreshes our mind and gives us comfort. A simple scene from nature can become a source of happiness for a long time.

IF

The poem “If—” by Rudyard Kipling teaches us how to become a good and successful person in life. The poet gives advice to his son and tells him to develop good habits and strong character.

The poet says that we should stay calm when others are worried. We should trust ourselves, but we should also listen to others. We must never tell lies, even if people lie about us. We should never hate anyone, even if someone hates us.

“Don’t give way to hating.”

He tells us to dream, but not become lost in dreams. We should think wisely and work hard. We must stay strong in good times and bad times, because both come and go.

“Meet with Triumph and Disaster the same.”

The poet also says that we should not give up easily. We must use our time, mind, and energy in a useful way. If we stay honest, patient, brave, and kind, we will succeed in life and become a complete human being.

“Yours is the Earth and everything in it.”
